

The villa is surrounded by a terraced garden where fragrant flowers and herbs blend seamlessly with the landscape, giving way to a spacious, sun-drenched lawn. Ancient olive trees cast gentle shade while framing unforgettable views of the sparkling sea. Although Property 10291 does not boast its own private pool, guests are warmly invited to enjoy the pristine swimming pool of the neighbouring villa whenever it is unoccupied or exclusively reserved, adding a touch of luxury and leisure to their stay.

Inside, the villa unfolds across a beautifully regular layout, with all rooms arranged on the same floor. Upon entering, you will find a refined entrance hall with a built-in wardrobe and an elegant office wall. A second arch from the entrance hall leads to a corridor that separates the sleeping quarters from the common areas. Here, a sequence of coloured stripes on the walls guides you to the three double bedrooms, each with its own distinct character. The red and blue striped room features a beamed ceiling

and en-suite bathroom with shower. The purple and russet striped room is enriched by a painted beamed ceiling and en-suite bathroom with tub. The green and ivory striped room has its own bathroom with shower.
