Location and Surrounding Area

Immersed in the peaceful Tuscan countryside, this carefully restored farmhouse is ideally located to explore the region's cultural highlights and spectacular natural wonders. With breathtaking views over the surrounding landscape, this five-bedroom property is perfect for unforgettable day trips to Tuscany's most beautiful towns and offers a unique opportunity to admire its splendid landscapes while soaking up the region's rich historical and cultural heritage.

In less than one hour by car, you can reach Florence, a treasure trove of art with a vibrant contemporary vibe. Beyond its extraordinary artistic heritage, a testament to centuries of civilisation, the best way to enjoy Florence is to stroll along the riverside avenues at sunset or lose yourself in the city's myriad alleyways of the bohemian Oltrarno or the narrow streets of San Niccolò, where it feels as though you have stepped into another era among its centuries-old walls.

In about an hour by car, you can reach the walled town of San Gimignano, one of Italy's best-preserved medieval villages. As you crest the nearby hills, the fourteen towers of the town rise like a medieval Manhattan. Today, not even the plague would deter the throngs of summer day-trippers, drawn by the palpable sense of history and the enchanting rural setting. The historic centre is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and strolling through the streets will make you feel as though you have stepped back in time.

The villa is also a few kilometres from the medieval town of Siena. Its ancient red brick buildings, the scallop-shaped Piazza del Campo, and the Cathedral Square dominated by the zebra-striped Duomo make it an absolute must-visit for anyone travelling to Tuscany. Effectively an open-air museum celebrating the Gothic, Siena boasts secular monuments that have retained both their medieval forms and exceptional art collections, providing plenty to marvel at.

The villa is a few kilometres from Volterra, one of Tuscany's most dramatic hilltop towns. Despite its many attractions, Volterra sees fewer tourists than other Tuscan towns, so you can expect to share its winding stone streets with locals and explore its ancient sites without crowds. Founded by the Etruscans and surrounded by medieval walls, Volterra has a notable historic centre filled with fascinating Roman ruins, medieval buildings, and alabaster workshops.

Villa Gran Madre offers a serene atmosphere and can accommodate up to eighteen guests in nine double bedrooms (or twelve guests in six double bedrooms), each with an en-suite bathroom.

Encircled by a lush garden, this magnificent property features an exceptional swimming pool and a generous paved poolside area furnished with comfortable sun loungers, inviting guests to relax and unwind. The poolside area provides an idyllic spot for sunbathing and enjoying moments of relaxation with a good book. The outdoor area also includes large parasols for ample shade on hot summer days.

Decorated in soft, natural tones, the spacious and well-maintained indoor areas feature antique furniture and original frescoes, creating a charming yesteryear atmosphere. The villa is set within a romantic park with monumental trees. Preserved spaces once used for cellars, including large barrels and a wine-

tasting area, add to the historical character. Recent renovations have introduced a welcoming reading room and an attractive lounge area opening onto a panoramic terrace.

The original private chapel on the ground floor provides a picturesque venue for romantic and intimate weddings. The ground floor also includes a spacious entrance, a cosy reading room with a stone fireplace, a comfortable lounge area with a TV, a generous dining room, a magnificent living room with three doors leading to a panoramic terrace, a cosy breakfast room with a fireplace, and a fully equipped kitchen with all necessary amenities. A guest bathroom completes this level.

On the first floor, the villa accommodates up to eighteen guests in nine double bedrooms. This includes one bedroom with an en-suite bathroom featuring both a bathtub and shower, one with a bathtub, and seven with showers. Additional features include an extra bathroom with a large shower, a living room with original frescoes and a fireplace, and an additional living room.
