Location and Surrounding Area

Nestled in the heart of Tuscany in Montevettolini, this magnificent property is ideally situated to explore Tuscany's cultural highlights and natural wonders. Set on a hill surrounded by olive groves and lush vineyards, just a few kilometres from the charming towns of Florence and Pisa, this villa offers the perfect base for day trips to Tuscany's most beautiful towns. It provides a unique opportunity to admire the region's iconic landscapes while soaking up its rich historical and cultural heritage.

Montevettolini is a medieval village located outside the city of Pistoia. The village is peaceful, with historic palaces, churches, and winding streets offering breathtaking views. Take a stroll to see the Church of San Michele Arcangelo and its bell tower, and, if you are fortunate, you might catch the Medieval Feast which occurs once a year. Montevettolini is part of Monsummano Terme, known for its spas, Etruscan ruins, and ancient walls. Pistoia, the medieval city, is the capital of the province where Montevettolini and Monsummano Terme are situated.

The property is also just a few kilometres from Lucca, known as "the city of 100 churches." Hidden behind impressive Renaissance walls, its cobbled streets, delightful squares, and shady promenades make it a perfect destination for exploring on foot. At the end of the day, open-air cafes and historic restaurants tempt visitors to relax with a glass of Lucchese wine and a meal prepared with fresh produce from nearby Garfagnana.

In about fifty minutes by car, you can reach Viareggio, the principal city in Versilia. Established as a port of Lucca, this popular sun-and-sand resort is renowned for its flamboyant Carnevale, second only to Venice's carnival, and for its Art Nouveau facades along the seafront, reminiscent of the town's 1920s and '30s heyday. Stroll along the charming streets of the city centre, enjoy a gelato on the Passeggiata, and gaze out to the sea on the Dersena.

In less than an hour by car, you can easily reach Pisa, renowned for its Leaning Tower. As you navigate its alleys and riversides, you will discover architectural jewels such as Santa Maria della Spina, the headquarters of the Scuola Normale Superiore in Piazza dei Cavalieri, the exhibitions at Palazzo Blu, and the magnetic charm of Piazza dei Miracoli. Start from the Baptistry and head towards the 130-metre Camposanto Monumentale overlooking the square.

In just one hour by car, you can reach Florence, a treasure trove of art with a vibrant contemporary atmosphere. Beyond its extraordinary artistic heritage, a testament to centuries of civilisation, the best way to enjoy Florence is to stroll along the riverside avenues at sunset or get lost in the myriad alleyways of the bohemian Oltrarno or the narrow streets of San Niccolò, where you feel as though you have stepped back in time along its centuries-old walls.

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The Property

Built in the 16th century, this grand mansion was once one of the twelve sumptuous hunting lodges of Grand Duke Ferdinando I, grandson of the famous Lorenzo de' Medici. Combining historic charm with modern conveniences, Property 1557152223 has been exquisitely restored while preserving its original atmosphere. The villa can accommodate up to twelve guests, featuring six bedrooms (four double bedrooms and two twin rooms), each with an en-suite bathroom, spread over two floors.

This property is steeped in history, having hosted guests such as Paolina Bonaparte and the Grand Duchess of Tuscany. The interior of the house is adorned with luxurious touches that invite relaxation and a sense of aristocracy upon entering the estate. This exclusive property, owned by a prominent

Italian family, welcomes guests with its beauty and charm. One word: opulence. Guests are surrounded by art, chandeliers, murals, Persian rugs, antiques, fireplaces, and vaulted ceilings.

Set amidst a lush Italian garden, the villa features a monumental staircase leading to a large swimming pool and a spacious poolside area with sun loungers, perfect for unwinding. There is also a pool house with a changing area and a game room with a table tennis table, plus multiple spots for relaxing with a good book. This room also includes a small fridge. Surrounded by lemon trees and bushes, the garden features an exclusive al fresco dining area shaded by greenery, with stone and marble tables and chairs overlooking the pool.

The villa has been carefully restored and enhanced by the current owner, whose family acquired the property more than 200 years ago. Guests enter the villa to find a ground floor perfect for hosting dinners, featuring a formal dining room with a fireplace that comfortably seats twenty guests. There is also an additional dining room and a spacious, fully-equipped gourmet kitchen with two fridges, an ice maker, a coffee machine, a dishwasher, and an oven.

The ground floor also includes a bathroom with a shower and two bedrooms for staff. Please note that these two rooms are not included in the rental price but are available on request at an additional cost. Two separate staircases lead to the upper floor, which features a billiard room, a consecrated private chapel, a generous living room with two sitting areas, comfortable sofas, a piano, a reading room with a library, and a cosy living room with a fireplace.

The villa features six bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms. On the ground floor, there are two bedrooms: a double bedroom with an en-suite bathroom with a shower and a double bedroom with an en-suite bathroom with a bathtub.
