

Location and Surrounding Area

Located in Venice and just steps from the most exclusive dining, shopping, and entertainment options, this unique four-bedroom property is the perfect place for a stylish break in one of the most beautiful cities in Italy. Suite Morosini Brandolin is in the lively and central San Polo district, in the center of Venice. The house is just a 10-minute walk from Piazza San Marco and close to some of the major attractions, but is slightly off the beaten track, offering shelter from hit-and-run tourism.

Thanks to its iconic canals and more than 100 islands connected by 400 bridges, visiting Venice is like being in a real-life fairytale. Each island, in turn, is adorned with magnificent palazzos and priceless art. The Grand Canal thoroughfare, where gondolas and river traffic provide a steady stream of activity, is one of the most photographed scenes in the world. Saint Mark's Basilica, with its interior adorned with stunning Byzantine mosaics, and the Campanile bell tower are in Piazza San Marco.

In Venice, water is everywhere. The Grand Canal, the city's greatest draw, is its infrastructure. It flows like a snake, past opulent mansions, aristocratic buildings, all the way to the open lagoon. With taxi boats running up and down, it can get busy during rush hour, but after lunch, when most people are off to rest, it is much quieter. Though it may sound cliché, seeing Venice and skipping a traditional guided gondola ride would be like visiting Rome without seeing the Colosseum.

The Ponte di Rialto is a pearl-white, geometric bridge that is the most important of the roughly 400 bridges in the Venetian archipelago. It is one of the few in the world to have artisan boutiques constructed onto it, including jewelers and silk shops selling handcrafted creations. Every morning, chefs from restaurants come to buy fresh fruit and vegetables from the farmers' market. With zero food miles, all products are sourced locally from the nearby rural areas.

The most enjoyable month to visit Venice is February, when the centuries-old Carnival takes place. Millions of partygoers from around the globe get wild and dress up as masquerades. It used to be an open invitation to debauchery, with people free to act however they pleased as long as their identity was a secret. Today, it is an open-air runway of ball gowns, black capes, feathery hats, and sparkly masks. To enjoy the confetti-showered spectacle while avoiding the crowd, take a seat at one of the cafés lining Saint Mark's Square.
