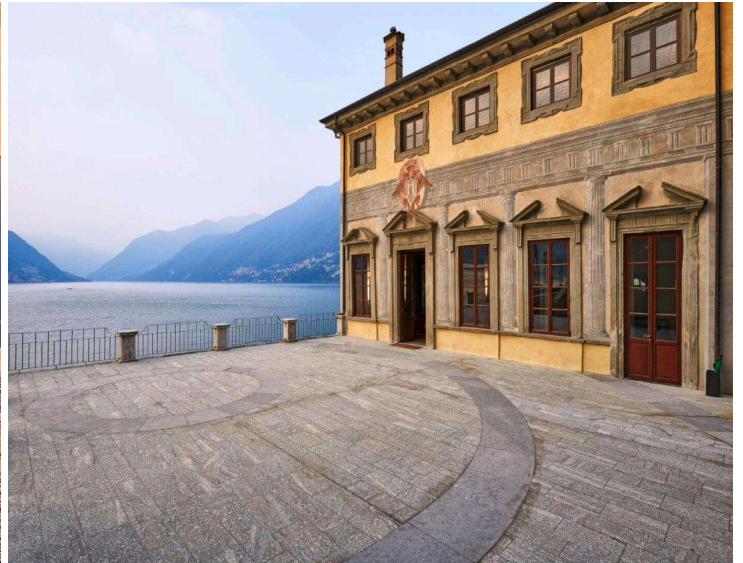

Suite Belgiojoso:

Suite Visconti:

Honouring the Visconti Borromeo family, who owned the villa in the 18th century, Suite Visconti is located on the first floor, offering breathtaking views of both the lake and the villa's gardens. Suite Wagram:

Named after Anne Berthier de Wagram, a guest of Prince Emilio Barbiano Belgiojoso, Suite Wagram is so intimately connected to the lake that one might feel as if they could touch its waters from the windows. This charming and intimate retreat accommodates two guests in a sumptuous double bedroom with two bathrooms, alongside a well-equipped kitchen, dining room, and refined sitting room.

Plini House:

Dedicated to Lake Como's renowned naturalists, Plini House is set within the villa's parkland, serving as the gateway to scenic woodland trails leading to the Tea House. Accommodating eight guests in total, each of its four sumptuous double bedrooms enjoys a private bathroom and a small terrace, offering unparalleled views of the estate. Suite Shelley:
