Palazzo Manduria is 34 km from Taranto-Grottaglie Airport, 49 km from Brindisi–Salento Airport, and 156 km from Bari Karol Wojtyśa Airport. The property is just 1 km from Manduria (just 450 m on foot), 29 km from Porto Cesareo, 42 km from Ostuni, 48 km from Martina Franca, 49 km from Taranto, 49 km from Lecce, 57 km from Gallipoli, 64 km from Alberobello, and 97 km from Otranto.

Location and Surrounding Area

Property 1637597785 enjoys a truly enchanting setting in the heart of Manduria. Here, vineyards and ancient olive groves blend gently into the edges of the historic town, creating a peaceful transition between countryside and urban charm. In the distance, the Ionian Sea traces a soft line on the horizon, adding a touch of light. Secluded yet well connected to the cultural richness of the Salento region, the palace offers a quiet retreat immersed in nature, history, and the timeless atmosphere of southern Italy.

The palace is set on the edge of Manduria, a town celebrated for its ancient Messapian heritage and its deep connection to wine culture. This is the homeland of the renowned Primitivo di Manduria, whose vineyards stretch across the sun-drenched landscape, shaping a scenery of rolling vines and silver-leaved olive trees. Wandering through the old town, visitors discover stone-built streets, hidden courtyards, and a timeless atmosphere where Southern Italian traditions are still beautifully preserved.

Beyond Manduria lies the wider region of Salento, one of the most evocative corners of southern Italy, where culture, architecture, and coastline come together in perfect harmony. The baroque splendour of Lecce, often called the “Florence of the South”, offers ornate churches and golden-hued palazzi, while nearby coastal gems such as Otranto and Gallipoli reveal crystal-clear waters and historic harbours. This is a land where every town tells a story, shaped by centuries of Mediterranean influences and artistic heritage.

The surrounding coastline is equally captivating, with both the Ionian and Adriatic seas within easy reach. Soft sandy beaches, hidden coves, and protected natural areas offer endless opportunities for relaxation and exploration. The Ionian coast, in particular, is known for its calm turquoise waters and long, unspoilt stretches of sand, where the rhythm of life slows to the gentle sound of the sea. It is a landscape that invites long, unhurried days by the water, framed by light, wind, and the unmistakable beauty of southern Italy.

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The Property

Nestled where the vineyards and olive groves of Apulia gently give way to the winding streets of Manduria, and watched over by the distant arc of a crystalline sea, stands Property 1637597785, a noble 19th-century residence of extraordinary charm. Built in 1881 to celebrate the wedding of the young Countess Sabini di Altamura and Don Tommaso Schiavoni-Tafari, the palace today blends authentic Apulian hospitality with an international sensibility. The property accommodates up to 16 guests across 8 refined suites.

The estate unfolds across approximately 4,000 m² of romantic English-style gardens, where Mediterranean essences drift through pathways lined with roses, jasmine, and centuries-old oaks dating back to 1880. The landscape evolves naturally into a wooded grove of oaks, evoking a sense of serenity, while elegant terraces open onto the verdant scenery. Outdoor life here is elevated by a saltwater swimming pool immersed in greenery, offering a truly secluded and tranquil retreat.

Inside, the palace reveals its aristocratic soul through frescoed ceilings, neoclassical ornamentation, and rooms where antique furnishings meet refined contemporary design in perfect equilibrium. The atmosphere is curated according to the ancient principles of Feng Shui, ensuring harmony between architecture, nature, and comfort. This balance of eras and aesthetics transforms each space into an intimate yet majestic retreat, where history is not merely preserved but gracefully lived.

Within its storied walls, neoclassical frescoes, finely decorated rooms, and period furnishings create a dialogue between centuries of family history and the subtle wisdom of Feng Shui, shaping a stay that feels both rooted and transcendent. The palace's eight suites each offer a distinctive interpretation of elegance, all featuring en-suite bathrooms and consistent high standards of comfort, differing only in size (ranging from 25 to 35 m²) and character.

Located on the first floor, the Heritage Suite (32 m²) boasts pastoral ceiling frescoes and wall decorations that evoke centuries of noble storytelling. The adjoining lounge reveals vaulted ceilings adorned with antique bas-reliefs. The Colonial Suite (35 m²) is draped in silks and velvets in silver and azure tones, featuring a panoramic Saint-Jean wallpaper depicting an 18th-century landscape. A sculptural bathtub placed at the centre of the room completes its -chic aesthetic.

The Black Wine Suite (32 m²) channels the timeless glamour of Art Deco and the Roaring Twenties. Upholstered in silks and velvets in grey and gold tones, it offers a sophisticated retro atmosphere. It includes a French-style double bathroom and can be configured with either a double bed or twin beds. The Art Deco Suite (34 m²) is inspired by the elegance of the 1930s and boasts beige, gold, and silver tones. Guests benefit from a safe, study corner, relaxation area with coffee and herbal teas, and shower.

The Bohemian Suite (32 m²) embraces a chic boho spirit in green and orange hues, enriched with silk and velvet furnishings. It features an antique family canopy bed or twin configuration, and en-suite bathroom with shower. This suite can communicate with Gipsy Suite upon request. The Gipsy Suite (29 m²) blends beige and orange tones with antique furnishings from the family dowry. It offers a spacious bathroom with bathtub, shower, and double washbasin. Like its counterpart, it can also be configured as twin beds.

The remaining rooms at Property 1637597785 further enrich the residence's refined collection of accommodations. The Terrace Suite (28 m²) is located on the first floor and features a double bedroom with an en-suite bathroom with shower, complemented by a private terrace. The Country Suite (28 m²) is dressed in soft, pastel tones and carries a gentle, nostalgic charm, with garden views and a double bed. Its cosy bathroom includes both a bathtub and a walk-in shower, creating an inviting balance between comfort and understated rural elegance.

At Property 1637597785, breakfast is far more than a meal, it is an experience in itself. Served in three enchanting settings, the loggia, the terrace, and the frescoed dining hall, it unfolds against breathtaking views and is composed of an abundant selection of organic, locally sourced sweet and savoury delicacies. The palace's dining experience is equally evocative: the Contessa's table becomes a living canvas of Apulian colours and flavours.
